Medieval Meandering, English Style

Join us as we walk, trot, jostle, row, and sail around, to and from England. Conquests, crusades, and pilgrimage were only a few of the reasons for travel in the Middle Ages. Whether seeking divorce in Rome, importing Rhenish wine, expanding wool trade, crusading in the Baltic area, or just being tourists, medieval people (women too) traveled more than we often think. We'll encounter a few characters from last summer's Medieval Mayhem — with no dates to memorize, just interesting accounts of life on the road.

Big Chico Creek Ecological Reserve

Education Coordinator Jon Aull is offering a four-part series on Chico's little known gem of a natural area—the 3,950 acre Big Chico Creek Ecological Reserve. This protected land is open to the public, with many special opportunities to observe wildlife—even help with the banding, tagging, and identification of birds, butterflies, and other species. Vehicle access is limited, so this is a rare chance to be shuttled 1000 ft. down into the Canyon to view the Chico formation, an ancient seabed studded with fossils. There will be an option for hiking for those who want to stretch their legs.

Fundamentals of Drawing (Introductory with Pencil)

Paper is a two-dimensional surface. Every line you draw on it is in the exact same plane as the paper. In order to create the appearance of three dimensions, you need to create an illusion. In this course you will learn how to apply proven fundamentals to create that illusion. No experience required!

Art Lecture & Bus Trip~ Truth and Beauty: The Pre-Raphaelites and the Old Masters

Our summer arts trip to the Legion of Honor in San Francisco features the exhibit "Truth and Beauty: The Pre-Raphaelites and the Old Masters." A pre-trip lecture by artist Dolores Mitchell, who has taught 19th Century European art and published research on it, will be held June 27 and will provide an introduction to the art and artists in preparation for the June 30 bus trip.

This exhibit includes Pre-Raphaelite paintings and Old Master sources of inspiration such as by Fra Angelico and Botticelli. As they aged, the Pre-Raphaelites painted increasingly lush, intricate works with dark psychological undertones. Using wives and mistresses as models, they created archetypal images of women as either redeemers or as femme fatales.
