- To register for credit, visit rce.csuchico.edu/naea to register & pay for units online and submit your record of participation, or to download a mailable registration form.
- Each semester unit on a Chico State transcript is just \$85. Three units of graduate credit, available for the NAEA School for Art Leaders program, are \$900 (\$300/unit).
