Evidence Based Practice: Antecedent Based Interventions

What is an Antecedent Based Intervention?

Environmental modifications purposefully designed and implemented to change the conditions that prompt the target behavior

Antecedent Based Intervention

Other Evidence Based Procedures which align with ABI's: Functional Behavior Assessment Self-Monitoring (Differential) Reinforcement Naturalistic Intervention Visual Supports

Motivating Operations

Environmental variables that change:

- The effectiveness of a behavioral consequence
- The frequency of the behavior associated with the consequence

Two types of Motivating Operations are:

- Establishing Operations
- Abolishing Operations
 - Motivating Operations example

Understanding Motivating Operations is a key aspect to implementing Antecedent Based Interventions
