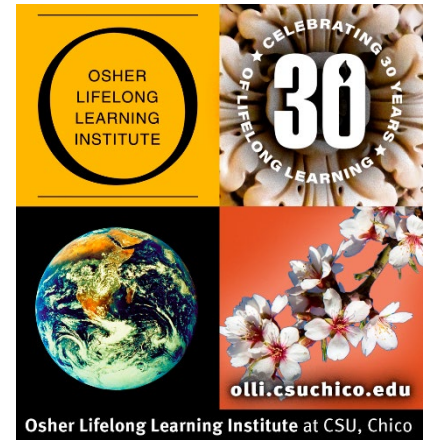

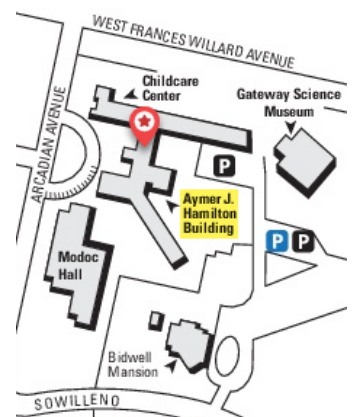
WHERE IS THE OLLI OFFICE LOCATED?
