Medieval & Renaissance, London, York & Stratford-Upon-Avon

This London Program allows students to experience visual and theatrical art in person. Two Chico State faculty, Dr. Erin Kelly (Department of English) and Dr. Asa Mittman (Department of Art & Art History) are specialists in English art and literature and will bring students to major sites central to Britain's long and storied history. The program will be based in London, where students will see works of art at the British Museum and the National Gallery, and manuscripts at the British Library. The group will study the architecture of Westminster Abbey, see a play at the Globe Theatre, and dig for artifacts on the banks of the Thames River. Excursions will include York to see the majestic Gothic York Minster and Rievaulx Abbey, and Stratford-upon-Avon to visit Shakespeare's birthplace and take in a performance by the Royal Shakespeare Company.

YOUR PROGRAM INCLUDES

London:

- Accommodation in twin or triple-bedded rooms within a centrally-located shared, self-catered apartment.
- Oyster Card valid for unlimited use on the London buses and underground trains in zones 1 & 2.
- Orientation program in London consisting of an orientation meeting with AIFS staff, information on safety and security, and a local area walking tour.
- Visits to various London attractions such as the Tower of London, Whitehall Palace Banqueting House, the Victoria & Albert Museum, the British Museum and Westminster Abbey.
- Guided tour of Middle Temple Hall, followed by a three-course group lunch.
- Tickets to the Shakespeare's Globe Theatre, for both a standing matinee and a seated evening performance.

- Group afternoon tea at the Kensington Palace Pavilion and Tea Room.
- Full-day excursion to Cambridge including transportation, a walking tour, entrance to King's College and Corpus Christi College Library.

York:

- Accommodation in twin or triple-bedded hotel rooms, with daily breakfast.
- Visit with guided tour of York Minster and the Tower.
- Visit to Clifford's Tower and the Merchant Adventurer's Hall.
- Full-day excursion to Durham to include transportation and entrance to Durham Cathedral.
- Full-day excursion to Rievaulx Abbey including transportation and entrance to the abbey.



Stratford-upon-Avon:

- Accommodation in twin or triple-bedded rooms within a centrally-located shared, self-catered apartment.
- Visit to Kenilworth Castle and Elizabethan Gardens.
- Royal Shakespeare Company Behind-The-Scenes Tour, and tickets to an evening theater performance.
- Tickets to an evening theater performance by the Royal Shakespeare Company.
- Visit to Shakespeare's Birthplace, New Place and Hall's Croft.

Also:

- International Student Identity Card.
- Access to the wireless-enabled AIFS Student Center for the London section, and a team of experienced AIFS Student Services staff for information, personal advising/counseling and 24-hour emergency contact service;
- Medical and program fee refund insurance policies.

FEES

Based on an enrollment of 8-11 participants, the fee per person is \$5,825. This fee excludes round-trip airfare, optional homestay accommodation (London section), optional cell phone purchase, CSU Chico tuition/fees, passport and visa fees if applicable.

ACADEMIC CREDIT

This Faculty-Led program offers six units of academic credit:

- ARTH 400: Medieval Art & Architecture in England
- ENGL 441W/446: Shakespeare/British Renaissance Literature

Registration through CSU, Chico for both courses is required.
