# **International Nurse Remediation Program**

The International Nurse Remediation Program from the California State University, Chico School of Nursing provides concurrent theory and clinical courses for nurses who have been educated outside of the United States and who must remediate deficiencies in their education as determined by the State of California Board of Registered Nursing (BRN) in order to take the National Council Licensure Examination (NCLEX) and receive their nursing license.

## **Summer 2022: Jun 1-Aug 16**

All program courses have been approved by the California Board of Registered Nursing (BRN) and, when taken concurrently, satisfy the BRN's maternal requirements for internationallytrained nurses to take the state licensing exam.

## **Eligibility:**

Applicants must have finished nursing school in the last 5 years or worked as a nurse in the last 10 years.

Applicants must submit a letter from the Board of Registered Nursing indicating the course(s) needed.
