

NAEA-CSU, Chico Podcast about professional development opportunities
July 2018

Hello there! This podcast explains what you, as a NAEA member, need to do to apply for university credit for professional development from the nationally-accredited School of Education at California State University, Chico.

University credits are accepted by most school districts as evidence of high quality professional development for the purpose of licensure, assessment, and compensation. Getting credit is easy. **Be sure, however, to check with your specific school district about what they expect.**

Here is the process:

You must be a NAEA member to participate.

To register for NAEA professional development

1. Visit NAEA's virtual.arteducators.org. Login using your NAEA member login. This is where you can find current and archived webinars and other NAEA learning opportunities. The virtual art educators site tracks your registration for the NAEA events you select and participate in.
2. Participate in NAEA webinars (live and/or archived), or combine webinar hours with the NAEA Virtual Conference hours and/or NAEA Pre-Convention Sessions to accumulate 15 hours within the same twelve-month period. 15 hours = 1 unit.
3. After completing 15, 30, or 45 hours in NAEA professional development opportunities, access your personalized record from Virtual Art Educators by returning to virtual.arteducators.org and log in using your NAEA login. Once there, you want to download a pdf of the hours you have accrued so you can send this documentation to CSU, Chico as proof of your work and time.

How to Download Your Virtual Art Educators Transcript Once you are in your Virtual Art Educators account

1. Go to the "PROFILE" tab and enter your address
 2. Go to the "DASHBOARD" tab
 3. Click on "Transcript/Achievement" directly under "My Dashboard"
 4. Under Filter by date set the beginning and end dates for the hours you are logging for the credit you wish to apply for.
 5. Go to "Filter by type" and change it to "Credit Hour"
 6. Click "Download as PDF"
4. To register for university credit at CSU, Chico, visit Regional & Continuing Education's web site rce.csuchico.edu/naea .
At this site you register for specific NAEA courses and pay for units online. You will then email your pdf record of participation from the NAEA Virtual Art Educators site to rce@csuchico.edu (You can opt to download a mailable registration form for CSU, Chico on the website.) **When registering, please pay attention to deadline dates for the courses you select.**

Each semester unit on a CSU, Chico transcript is just \$85.

There is a downloadable pdf flyer available at this website that lists this information and also includes a chart of the NAEA opportunities available for credit, the instructional hours, the CSU, Chico course number, and when each course is offered during the year. Information for requesting your CSU, Chico transcript can also be found here.

A special note for those NAEA members who applied, were accepted, and are currently in the NAEA School for Art Leaders program. You can earn 3 units of professional development by enrolling in EDUC 852 Transformative Leadership for \$255 total--\$85/per unit.

OR

Three units of graduate credit at the master's degree level can be earned in the summer and/or fall semesters of the NAEA School for Art Leaders program. Cost is \$900 (\$300/unit). You must however be accepted into the School for Art Leaders to apply for these graduate units. Additional research and writing are required for these units and a letter grade is issued.

In summary, there are two main steps to follow.

1. Go to NAEA's Virtual Art Educators site to register and participate in professional development opportunities.
2. When you have accrued 15, 30, or 45 hours of professional development work, apply for university credit from Regional & Continuing Ed at CSU, Chico.
